This rubric applies to all projects. It is broken down into 6 categories with scoring from one to five, five being the highest or best.

*Purpose:* Does the item fulfill its intended purpose? 1 point for barely and 5 for a very good fit.

*Specifications:* Does the item meet the specifications laid out in its design? 1 point for at least using the right scale and 5 for a very good fit.

*Safety:* Was the piece completed without injury to people or property? 1 point for a serious loss time injury and 5 for none.

*Timing:* Was the piece completed on time? 5 points for on time, points off for each unit of delay.

*Budget:* Was the piece completed within the original budget projection or allotment? 1 point for making the piece multiple times and 5 for getting it right the first time.

*Aesthetics:* Does the piece do more than fill its function? Does it please the eye? It is pleasant to touch?
